

Art

Children will find out about Cave Art and create their own, using wax crayons.

DT

Children will learn how to make a stone age pouch. They will focus on the skill of sewing and understand how this pouch would have been used in the stone age.

French

Children will be learning basic French basics and then moving on to learning seasons.

Music

Using the stone age as a stimulus, children will learn to read, write & perform from notation using 1, $\frac{1}{2}$, 2 & 4 beat notes. Children will compose & perform rhythms.

PE

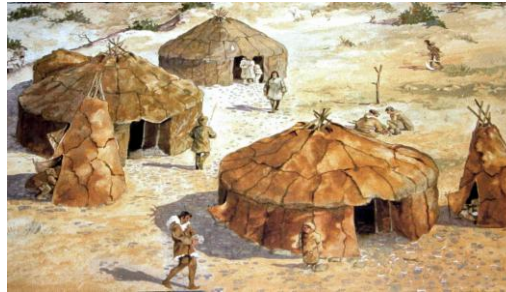
Ball handling - Children will learn a variety of ways of travelling with a ball. They will learn how to track a ball and how to send & receive a ball. Dance - the children will create a stone age dance in small groups to music. They will explore travel, balance & stillness and gestures.

Reading

Children will be taught to:

- Read a variety of texts, including fiction and non-fiction.
- Retrieve information from the text
- Infer information about the text, using clues read.
- Sequence and summarise a text.

History -

Children will learn about changes in Britain from The Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will specifically learn about:

- When the stone age was
- Late Neolithic hunter- gatherers and early farmers.
- Bronze Age Religion, technology and travel.
- Iron Age Hill - tribal kingdoms farming, art and Culture.

RE -

Special Times - How different religions celebrate different times. How Christmas is celebrated around the world and similarities and differences between these.

Science - Types of Rock

Children will learn all about the 3 main types of rock - Igneous, Sedimentary and Metamorphic. They will also build on their knowledge of fossils.

Maths

Place Value: Place value with two and three-digit numbers.

Order and compare two and three-digit numbers.

Place numbers on a number lines.

Compare and order numbers.

Addition and Subtraction: Add 1, 10 and 100.

Add 1-digit to 2-digit numbers mentally.

Subtract 1-digit from 2-digit numbers.

Mental addition and subtraction using place value, partitioning and counting back.

Mental addition of pairs of two-digit numbers by partitioning.

Mental subtraction of pairs of two-digit numbers by counting up.

Multiplication and Division: Use mental multiplication to double 2-digit numbers. Halve small even numbers.

Know $\times$ and $\div$ facts for 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Understand that multiplication is commutative. Recognise multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

English

Fiction - Stories with a Historical Setting

Children will read The Stone Age Boy and focus on features of the text, particularly, characters, setting and plot. They will practice writing using these features as well as conjunctions, direct speech, reference to historical language, and finish the unit by writing their own version of The Stone Age Boy.

Non-Fiction - Leaflets

Children will be looking at the features of leaflets and designing their very own leaflet for a Stone Age Theme Park!

Poetry - Stone age list poems

PSHE: Working together - Children will take part in role play, discussions and activities to give them strategies when faced with conflict and how to work as a team.
